Installing Sage 50 Manufacturing

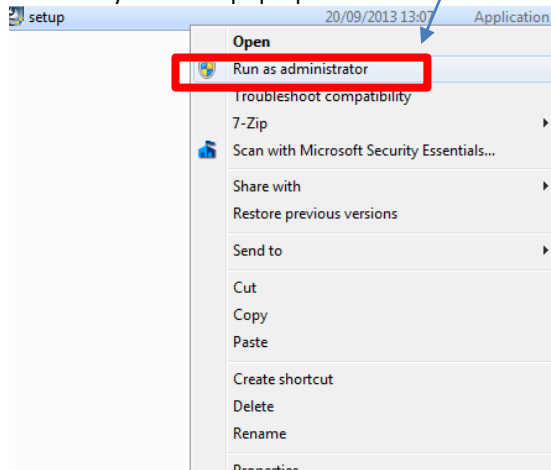


Requirements:

- In order to successfully install Sage 50 Manufacturing you must first:
 - Install SQL Server 2008 R2;
 - Install Sage 50 Accounts;

Installation:

- Right click on the installation file and click **"Run as administrator"**:
 - Press yes on the pop-up to run as an administrator.



- Click "Install";



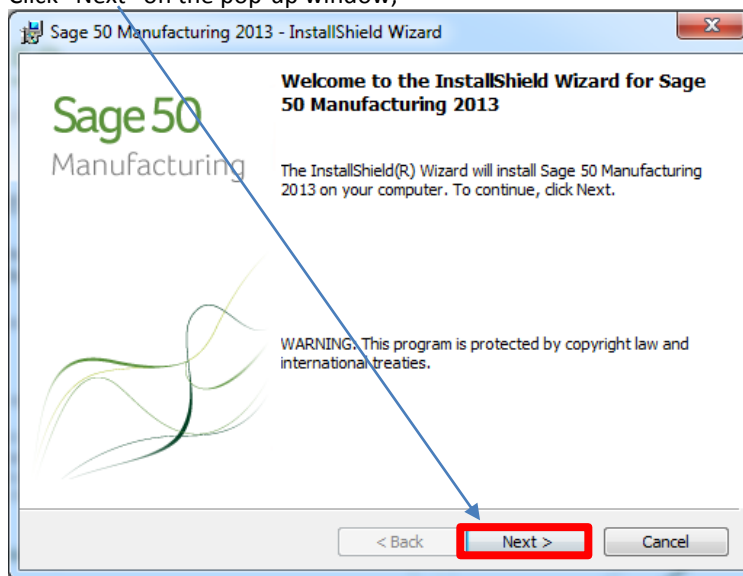

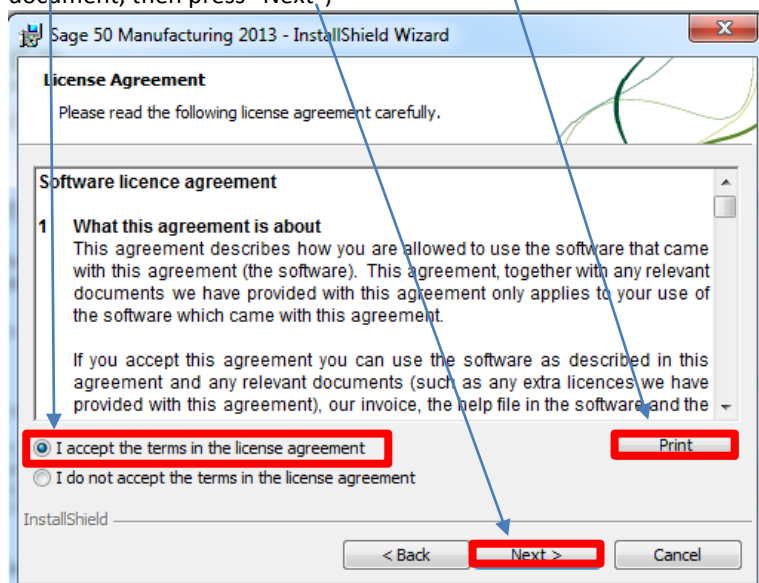
- Read and “Accept” the software licence agreement;



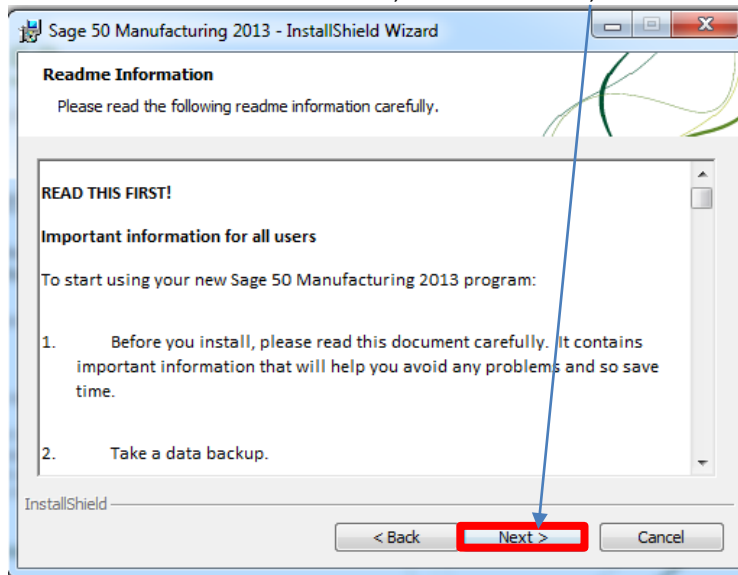
- Click “Next” on the pop-up window;



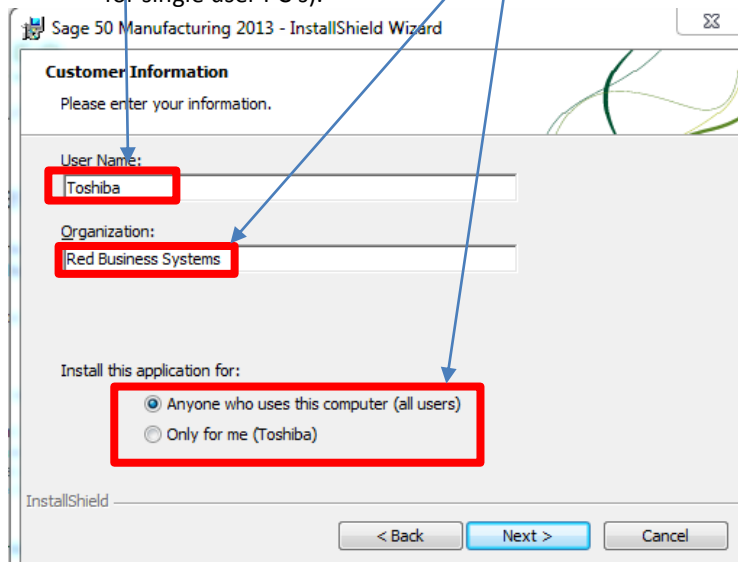
- “Accept” the licence agreement, click “Print” if you want to print the document, then press “Next”;



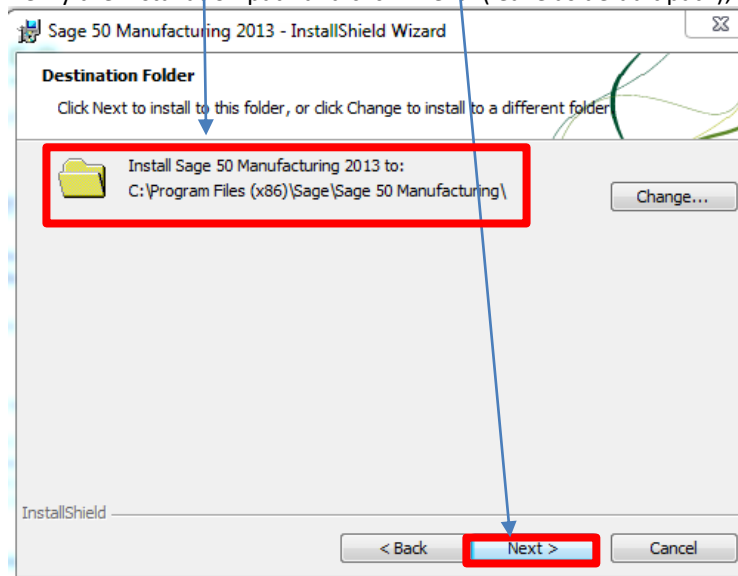
- Read over the "Readme" document, then click "Next";



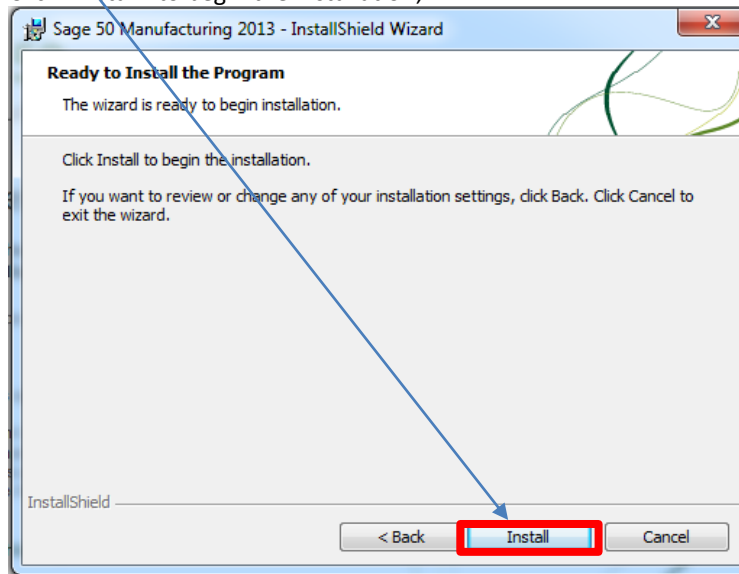
- Enter a name for the installation, and organisation name;
 - Select whether you wish to install Sage 50 Manufacturing for all users on your PC or just the account you're installing from (leave as default for single user PC's).



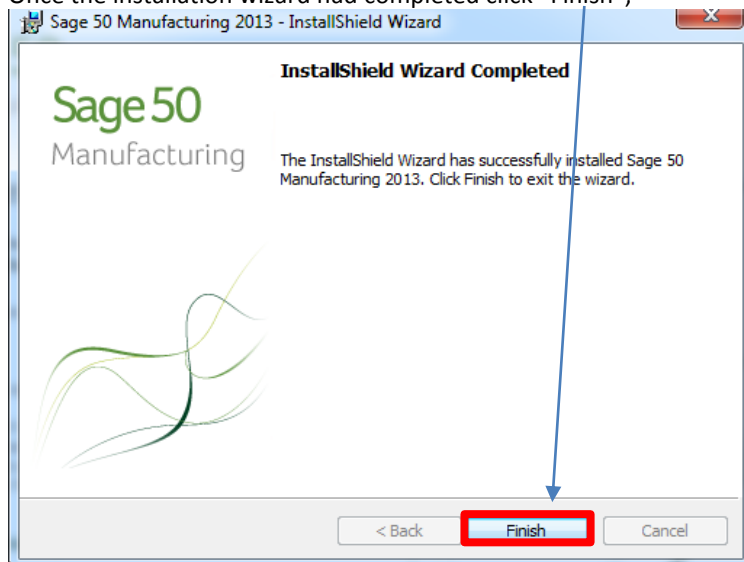
- Verify the installation path and click "Next" (leave as default path);



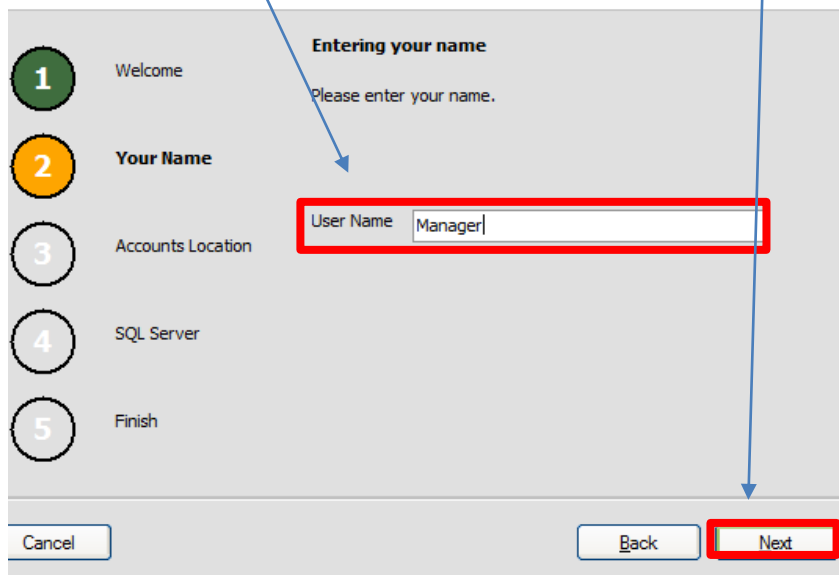
- Click "Install" to begin the installation;



- Once the installation wizard had completed click "Finish";



- Next open Sage 50 Manufacturing;
- This will open the initial set up of Sage 50 Manufacturing;
 - To start enter a username i.e "Manager" then click "Next";



- Select the path for your Sage 50 Accounts Installation, this will be done for you if the installation detects a Sage 50 Accounts installation, then click “Next”;
